Get ready for Spring!

In this week's communication there is a useful guide for getting 'bike ready' for the Spring. This leaflet offers guidance for how to check your bike, helmet and general bike maintenance.

Online Safety - Whats App

We are aware that many children have smart phones, and that some have access to WhatsApp. One major concern with WhatsApp is that the recommended age is 13, but many children as young as 6 or 7 are using the service. The maturity of users is a real concern when using the App because once videos, images and voice messages are shared, the users receiving them can then do what they want with them. This has implications















for the future and most children do not have the maturity levels to fully understand what this means for them as they grown into young adults.

Whilst you may feel that WhatsApp is suitable for your child, please be mindful of how they use this app. You may feel that it would be appropriate to monitor their activity, ensuring that they communicate with kindness.

Measles – is your family protected?

You will find included this week, a fact sheet on measles including more information on the symptoms and the MMR vaccination. It is never too late to catch up. The MMR vaccine is free on the NHS, whatever your age. You can protect your community - staff, carers and children - by encouraging uptake of the MMR vaccine which can be accessed via GP surgeries.
